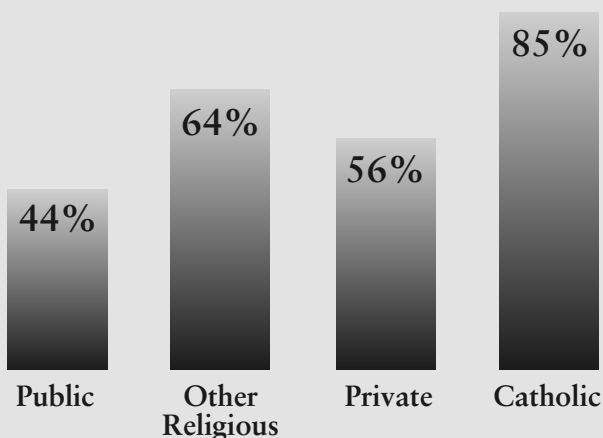

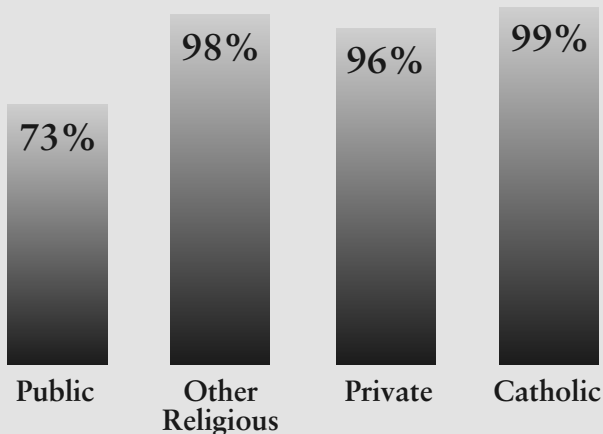
### College Matriculation 85%

# \$25 million in Financial Assistance for Catholic Education

- The Eastern Pennsylvania Scholarship Foundation awarded \$2.3 million in financial assistance this year.
- Schools then award additional financial assistance to families, based on need and available resources.
- The average tuition at our Catholic elementary schools is less than \$3,000, but the cost to educate one student is about \$5,000. Parish support helps each family provide this high quality academic and Catholic faith based education.

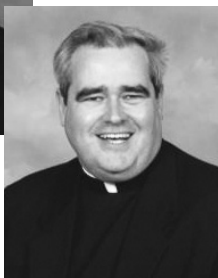
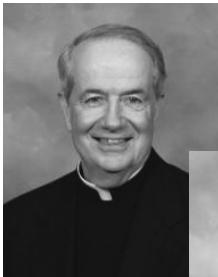
### TEACHERS

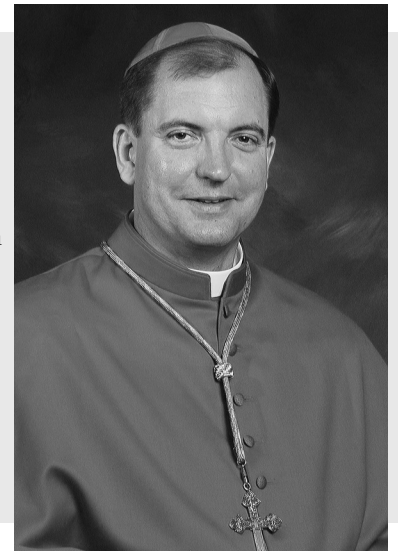
### PASTORS
